subcutaneously. Repeat in 21 to 28 days. Contact your veterinarian or the manufacturer for information on revaccination frequency.

Precautions: Store out of direct sunlight at 35-46°F (2-8°C). Do not freeze. Do not mix with other products. Use entire contents when first opened. Do not vaccinate within 21 days before slaughter. In case of anaphylactoid reaction, administer epinephrine. This product has not been tested in pregnant sheep. In case of human exposure, contact a physician immediately.
