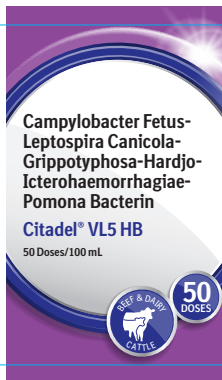

Indications: This product has been shown to be effective for the vaccination of healthy cattle against *Campylobacter fetus* var. *venerealis*, *Leptospira canicola*, *L. grippityphosa*, *L. hardjo*, *L. icterohaemorrhagiae*, and *L. pomona*. This product was licensed prior to the requirement to establish a minimum age for use. The duration of immunity has not been determined. This product has also been shown to be effective against urinary shedding of *L. borgpetersenii* serovar *hardjo* (type *hardjo-ovis*) and against infertility, delayed conception, or abortion due to *C. fetus* var. *venerealis*. Vaccinated animals subsequently exposed to *L. borgpetersenii* serovar *hardjo* (type *hardjo-ovis*) have been shown to clear renal infections within 8 weeks of exposure.

Directions and dosage: Mix well before use.



Using aseptic technique, inject 2 mL subcutaneously. Repeat in 14 to 28 days. Contact your veterinarian or the manufacturer for information on revaccination frequency.

Precautions: Store out of direct sunlight at 35–46°F (2–8°C). Do not freeze. Do not mix with other products. Use entire contents when first opened. Do not vaccinate within 21 days before slaughter. In case of anaphylactoid reaction, administer epinephrine. This product has not been tested in pregnant animals. In case of human exposure, contact a physician.

Preservatives: Neomycin and thimerosal.
